## Indiana Masonic Home Foundation 2016 Miller-Klingstein Ambassador's Award

To receive the Miller-Klingstein Award, an Ambassador must compile 60 points from those listed below between January 1, 2016, and January 31, 2017. [20 points] IMHF representative or Ambassador (including Ambassador from another Lodge) presents a program at Ambassador's Lodge. Ambassador must attend. Program should be outside Stated Meeting and involve spouses and other family members. Joint Lodge presentations qualify. [20 points] Ambassador presents a program at another Lodge or Masonic organization. [5 points] Ambassador makes a Quarterly Masonic Home Foundation report to his Lodge. [10 points] Ambassador presents the Annual Report of the Foundation to his Lodge. [5 points] Ambassador presents a plaque or a Gold Card to a member of his Lodge in Lodge or at the member's home.) [10 points] 3% of the members of Ambassador's lodge are Gold Card sponsors. [20 points] Ambassador obtains 3 first time Gold Card Sponsors from his lodge. [20 points] Ambassador assists in obtaining a Quarry Club or higher gift from a Lodge brother. [10 points] Ambassador attends one of the March 2016 Area Conference Ambassadors' meetings. [10 points] Ambassador attends the Ambassadors' meeting at the Compass Park Festival on September 11, 2016. [10 points] Ambassador visits the Masonic Home with one or more Lodge brothers. (Other than Festival Day.) [10 points] Ambassador refers a potential resident to Compass Park. [5 points] Lodge participates in the "Pillars" Adopt-A-Resident program or visits a resident of the Compass Park who is a member or relative of a member of the Lodge. [10 points] Ambassador attended 2015 Founders' Day or attends 2016 Founders Day. [10 points] Ambassador served 2 or more consecutive years as Lodge Ambassador.
