Through the years, the community grew and demand changed.


- There was a shift from care of children to care of seniors

In 2015 the campus was renamed Compass Park.

Independent Living

- Maintenance free ranch-style and duplex homes
- Each cottage or duplex has a garage, large yard and room for a garden
- Like any other neighborhood, the interior of each home reflects the unique taste of the owner and can be changed





Residential Apartments

- Three different floor plans, ranging from studio to 2 bedroom apartments
- Weekly housekeeping and bed linen change is provided
- Three meals are available each day





Assisted Living Apartments

- Built in 2011
- One-bedroom apartments with walk-in showers, cathedral ceilings and kitchenettes
- 24 hour assistance available for help with daily living activities





Transitional Care and Rehabilitation

We offer a wide range of therapeutic and medical services:

- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Dietary consultation
- Speech language pathology

- Lab work
- Pharmacy
- Radiology
- IV and enteral therapy





Skilled Nursing and Memory Care

- A place where seniors with special needs can flourish
- Provides social, physical, mental and emotional support, but promotes maximum independence
- Highly trained staff with specialized training in caring for those with memory loss and other special needs.





Skilled Nursing and Memory Care- Snoezelen Room

- A therapeutic environment for the treatment of seniors with dementia
- Promotes brain function through sensory stimulation
- Compass Park is the only skilled health facility in Indiana with this accommodation for residents
- Provides an alternative to drug therapy in some cases

Frequently Asked Questions

- What does it cost?
 - The cost of retirement living here at Compass Park is very competitive with, and sometimes lower than, other senior living facilities
 - Vast majority of residents choose NOT to give up their assets and instead pay a reasonable entry fee and monthly fee covering all expenses and assuring care for life
 - Members who have limited assets will always have an opportunity to apply for residency at Compass Park
 - If you have any questions please ask a representative
- What is the minimum age?
 - The minimum age in our senior living community is 55.
 - Fraternal Care age is 62
 - Federal Law requires a minimum age of 18 in our health care facility



Frequently Asked Questions

- Why do part of my annual dues go to support Compass Park?
 - Every Freemason in Indiana contributes a small amount annually
 - Compass Park will be a choice for Indiana Freemasons and members of Eastern Star when they are seeking a retirement community
 - Fraternal Support from dues covers about 4.5% of the operating budget of Compass Park
 - This support will help perpetuate Compass Park
